## Inquest into the Death of Chris Prasad COR 2013 0273

Pursuant to section 72(3) of the *Coroners Act 2008* (Vic), Monash Health's response to Coroner Jamieson's recommendations is as follows.

## 1. Recommendation 1

## 2. Recommendation 2

Monash Health supports this recommendation. Please find below a copy of the additions to the Monash Health policy entitled 'Monash Health – Leave from inpatient units' that specifically relate to environmental and climate conditions.

(a) Additional bullet point under Precautions and Contraindications section:

Patients prescribed Clozapine may be less able to recognise changes in temperature and therefore are at increased risk during extreme weather conditions.

(b) Additional bullet point under clause 1.1.2:

Environmental risk assessment should include a consideration of the forecasted weather for the period of leave, with particular notice of extreme weather conditions (very hot or very cold).

## (c) New clause 1.1.10:

For all leave requests clinical staff must consider the weather forecast for the duration of the planned and/or leave period. On days of extreme heat, clinical staff must consider if the weather conditions mean that it is inappropriate to grant leave.
