**INVESTIGATION INTO THE DEATH OF MICHAEL S DALY  
PTV'S RESPONSE TO THE CORONER'S RECOMMENDATION**

I refer to your letter to Public Transport Victoria (PTV) received on 4 July 2016 and the Finding into Death without Inquest including recommendations made by the coroner under the *Coroner's Act 2008 (Vic) (the Act)*. Thank you for the extension of time to respond to the Coroner's recommendation.

Pursuant to section 72(2) of the Act, Coroner Audrey Jamieson, made the following recommendation:

*The evidence suggests that the availability of a Global Positioning System (GPS) would have enabled the provision of more accurate information about Mr Daly's [the deceased] location on 22 August 2015, which may have in turn altered the outcome. With a view to avoiding like deaths, supporting train drivers and providing precise location coordinates at any one time, I recommend that Public Transport Victoria both accept, and provide the requested funding for, the Metro Trains Melbourne GPS proposal.*

***The coroner's recommendation has been implemented***

In consideration of Coroner Jamieson's Findings, I advise that the coroner's recommendation has been implemented by PTV.
