INVESTIGATION INTO THE DEATH OF MICHAEL S DALY PTV'S RESPONSE TO THE CORONER'S RECOMMENDATION

I refer to your letter to Public Transport Victoria (PTV) received on 4 July 2016 and the Finding into Death without Inquest including recommendations made by the coroner under the Coroner's Act 2008 (Vic) (the Act). Thank you for the extension of time to respond to the Coroner's recommendation.

Pursuant to section 72(2) of the Act, Coroner Audrey Jamleson, made the following recommendation:

The evidence suggests that the availability of a Global Positioning System (GPS) would have enabled the provision of more accurate information about Mr Daly's [the deceased] location on 22 August 2015, which may have in turn altered the outcome. With a view to avoiding like deaths, supporting train drivers and providing precise location coordinates at any one time, I recommend that Public Transport Victoria both accept, and provide the requested funding for, the Metro Trains Melbourne GPS proposal.

The coroner's recommendation has been implemented

In consideration of Coroner Jamieson's Findings, I advise that the coroner's recommendation has been implemented by PTV.
