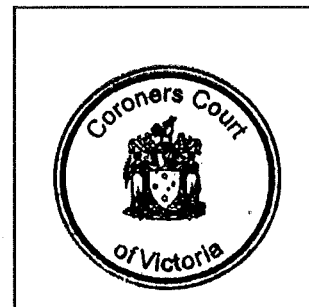
I further direct that this order remain in place until otherwise ordered, but no longer than 20 May 2022.
