I note the findings include a recommendation t	to the Department of Health

Recommendation 1:

The Victorian Department of Health consider amending the wording of the Statewide Referral Criteria regarding aortic aneurysm to clarify which patients should be discussed with the vascular registrar or sent to an emergency department, including the significance of transient symptoms.

The Coroner's recommendation will be implemented. The Department of Health has contacted the Vascular Clinical Review Panel who developed the current criteria. The panel members have recommended the panel be reconvened, as soon as practicable, to further discuss this recommendation to determine what if any changes are required to the aortic aneurysm statewide referral criteria.

If the clinical review panel decides to revise the wording, once formally approved, the department will then work with the Primary Health Network to update general practices' Health Pathways guides and undertake to educate general practitioners on the change. The statewide referral criteria website will then be updated to reflect the changes. It is anticipated any amended version of the aortic aneurysm statewide referral criteria would be implemented in the second half of 2022.

The Department of Health will provide you with an update once the clinical review panel has decided whether any changes will be made to the aortic aneurysm criteria.
